PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Jerome and Millcreek townships comprise the eastern portion of Union County. These areas are currently transitioning from predominately rural land uses to residential subdivisions, commercial office parks, retail centers and industrial uses. The prevalence of growth and development is increasing and is responsible for safety concerns and congestion. Union County's Comprehensive Plan, updated in 2013, outlined several transportation goals for the future in response to the rapidly developing area. Goals for the County's future included improved safety and maintenance, the consideration of access management issues, and the inclusion of alternative multi-modal transportation options.

BPS created a Plan for Eastern Union County to address existing and future concerns. In addition, the Plan was designed to serve as a guide for the development of a safe, efficient, and effective transportation network into the future. The Plan components included a problem statement, existing and future conditions information, existing and projected traffic analyses, alternative scenarios, and thoroughfare maps showing the existing and recommended network based on the alternative scenarios.
