PROJECT DESCRIPTION

For this project, BPS served as a subconsultant to develop a Sustainability Plan for the City of Dayton, Ohio, call “Renew Dayton.” The goal of the project was to create a community-focused collaborative process to develop an up-to-date shared vision for a sustainability strategy and a implementation plan.



BPS assessed current sustainability approaches; determined strengths and weaknesses; identified opportunities to improve the City’s practices; and solicited resident and stakeholder feedback on sustainability initiatives and programs. BPS also worked closely with the City to develop a clear consensus on program needs, concerns, and implementable strategies within the sustainability context.

As part of the planning process, BPS performed a comprehensive review of sustainability best practices nationwide to inform the content of the Plan, covering topics such as Energy, Green Economy & Market Development, Environmental Protection & Conservation Practices, Transportation, Sustainable Planning, Infrastructure & Design, Health & Well-Being, Waste Reduction, Social Equity, and Engaging Dayton. Additionally, BPS provided support for the design charrette and public meeting to collect valuable feedback on community goals.
