PROJECT DESCRIPTION

BPS continued to assist ODOT's Local Technical Assistance Program with administration of the Active Transportation Academy for a third year. BPS developed new courses, revised existing courses, facilitated trainings, created e-learning courses, and promoted the ATA program at an event.

BPS taught 6 in-person trainings and 1 virtual training (due to COVID-19). BPS also facilitated 1 webinar and gave a presentation on ATA to OARC. In addition, the BPS team designed and developed 4 e-learning courses using Lectora software: *Active Transportation Basics*, *Mobility Solutions*, *Safe Routes to School Basics*, and *Traffic Calming for Active Transportation*.

BPS promoted ATA at 1 conference and also prepared program guidance documents, including developing the *Selecting Host Communities White Paper* to help guide future training type selections and the *ATA Course Assessment Report* to evaluate existing ATA courses and formats.
