PROJECT DESCRIPTION

BPS supplemented the Engineering Department staff to provide services related to the City's capital improvement program and private development program. BPS served as the project manager for the City's first two Sidewalk Maintenance Programs and helped the City evaluate and implement improvements to the existing program. The team also provided assistance in reviewing design plans, reports, data, and specifications prepared by other consultants. Review of data also included performing analysis of the data and associated graphics for review and use by City staff. In addition, BPS served as a resource to the Department for evaluating and recommending improvements to their programs, procedures, and processes.
