PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, local jurisdictions must have a disaster mitigation plan in effect to receive funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for pre-disaster mitigation activities. For this project, BPS served as a subconsultant and assisted in preparing the update to the Cuyahoga County Hazard Mitigation Plan with the purpose of identifying and assessing the hazards that pose the greatest risk to Cuyahoga County and its communities.

BPS organized and facilitated extensive stakeholder and public outreach and engagement activities designed to encourage participation from representatives of cities, villages, community organizations, as well as the members of the public throughout the County. Community participation was closely monitored, and feedback was collected through Google forms and analyzed to prepare mitigation action recommendations.

The BPS team also prepared the plan integration strategy that involves the incorporation of hazard mitigation principles and actions into community plans and community planning mechanisms into hazard mitigation plans.

After review and approval by the Ohio and Federal Emergency Management Agencies, the BPS team assisted communities with plan adoption.
