PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Active Transportation Academy (ATA) offers in-person and virtual trainings along with e-learning courses for Ohio communities and their representatives who are involved in active transportation projects and programs. ATA has provided education and training to over 1,000 learners across Ohio. BPS has assisted ODOT with the ATA for 5 consecutive years over 4 contracts. BPS has created and updated 15 courses to-date. These courses include both inperson and e-learning formats. Course topics include, but are not limited to:
