PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Burton Planning Services led the effort to create an Active Transportation Plan (ATP) for the City of Gahanna through the Ohio Department of Transportation’s Statewide Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning Task Order. This project aimed to not only improve safety across the multi-modal transportation system, but also to enhance Gahanna with a more walkable and bikeable environment.

To achieve this, BPS conducted a thorough data collection and analysis effort. This data-driven approach, combined with in-depth analysis of existing conditions, provided a solid foundation for the development of a prioritized action plan.
